Industry Training

We intend to have our first strategy meeting in April to look at initiatives that are already underway and those that can deliver results in the short term while we work on longer-term strategic projects.

Council Update

The council has had its first meeting of the year, and it was positive to hear new council members bringing fresh views and ideas to the table. A number of topics were covered, including ratifying the formation of the training SIG. We also discussed moving some SIG meetings around the country to better engage with members and encourage more people to attend SIG meetings in person or via teleconferencing. Moving the meetings is impractical, but we can certainly run the odd smaller meeting out of town with the SIG chairs and some representation from the council. Please do let me know

if you are interested in attending meetings in Wellington or Christchurch.

FireNZ 2017

FireNZ 2016 was a tremendous success, and this year we return to the ASB Showgrounds in Greenlane, Auckland, and to our normal slot of earlier in the year: mark 11–13 October 2017 in your diary. The 3-day format of 2016's conference was also successful, so we will be doing this again. The format will be very similar, with seminars and site visits on day 1 and the full conference experience and trade show on days 2 and 3. We are also working on attracting a number of high-profile keynote speakers and will release their names closer to the event once confirmed. The FireNZ magazine is also nearly complete and will be released in March, so keep an eye out for it.

SIG Meetings

The first round of meetings have been held, and it is fair to say the engagement in many of them has been great. We have the chance to build on the solid framework from previous years and branch out into some new areas under the leadership of the new SIG chairs.

I can't emphasize enough that attending meetings and actively contributing to your chosen specialty not only gives you a voice but also helps shape the direction and future of the association and enables you to gain the greatest benefit from your membership. Teleconferencing, and sometimes video conferencing, is an option, and—

as mentioned—we intend to hold some sub-meetings around the country.

The following key objectives have been agreed and approved so far:

- **Passive SIG**

- The first project the passive SIG will undertake is a product listing register – a one-stop list of agreed approved products to be distributed to building industry professionals, IQPs, engineers, MBIE, BRANZ, and designers, to name a few.
- The second project will be around engineering judgements (EJs): how and by whom they are conducted and criteria for providing them.

- **HOFPE SIG**

- Much like the passive SIG project, the HOFPE SIG will also produce a product register so approved products from each manufacturer can be listed and easily referenced.

- **New Zealand Fire Equipment Manufacturers Association/FPANZ**

- The FEMA and FPANZ worked together to produce the gaseous suppression system code of practice CP01, which was very well received. They are now working on the second code of practice on water mist systems.

This is just a start of what is to come this year. They are all exciting projects for the association to work on and will deliver great results for the industry.

The latest new member to join our association is Trade Mark Design Ltd. It is always a pleasure to welcome new members, as this growth strengthens our voice, expertise, and membership base.

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

2017 is shaping up to be a great year for passive fire protection!

At the beginning of the year, we sat down and took a long hard look at what we believe would help the industry move forward to more positive ground.

We decided there were four main areas that needed addressing:

- 1) A range of technical booklets for different areas of passive fire protection that would provide technical guidance to industry on design, installation and inspection of passive fire protection products;
- 2) A passive fire protection training/qualification for all levels of industry;
- 3) Register of AS 4072.1 tested products by NATA approved laboratories;
- 4) Register of specialist passive fire protection installers, inspectors and designers.

If these building blocks were put in place, it would a) help industry understand why we need passive fire protection, b) ensure that the people designing, installing and inspecting were properly qualified, and c) that the products being installed met the NZ building code standards.

Our feeling was, that the only way these proposals would get real traction is if MBIE, industry and trade associations saw real worth in what we were planning and creating – with the hope that they might be adopted and recommended to industry in the future.

Initial meetings with MBIE and other industry trade associations has resulted in very positive feedback, so at our next passive SIG meeting we will be discussing the proposals and the best way forward in putting these proposals into practice!

Its going to be a hard slog – and we will need input from many – but we feel the end result will be worth it.

We welcome new members to the passive special interest group – sign up and come along!

SIG - Contractors: 2017 and beyond.

I feel I can offer to members my experience, and knowledge of our industry in NZ, and can associate with issues, and difficulties contractors encounter. 5. Identify this SIG's previous goals and achievements record.
6. Request for suggested direction the SIG Contractors would like the FPA to take them.

What next for SIG - Contractors and how do we get there?

With the full support of the FPA executive council, it was agreed that a greater level of engagement of this SIG is desired and necessary.

There are a number of initiatives the FPA Executive Council have discussed, these range from, though not limited to training, education, representation, submission etc.

I look forward to meaningful participation by SIG members to ascertain the preferred SIG 2017 initiatives.

I pledge to progress the direction our SIG would like the FPA to take them.

The most pressing topic we have at present I believe is the ongoing CO2 fire extinguisher investigations, Kim Comben from Worksafe is currently carrying out an investigation into several matters including ejecting valves, possible neck cracks & the re-testing of condemned cylinders. These investigations also involve the CTLA as well as both local & overseas companies' so it has become quite an involved & time consuming process.

Scott & I have both been in regular contact with Kim on these issues & look forward to being able to report the

results once the investigations have been completed. We are of course still assisting the Commerce Commission in their ongoing investigation into unethical fire equipment companies (update at the next meeting).

We have a number of projects to progress as a group this year including our Codes Of Practice for both service companies & Wholesalers, we also want to ensure that the fire extinguisher usage survey results (available on the NZFS website) are utilized to their best effect/maximum benefit, then there are possible changes/amendments to NZS 4503 Our first meeting of the year is being held at the FPA offices in Albany, the meeting is held at 9am on Monday the 13th February, we encourage all interested parties to attend.

Competenz, FPA New Zealand and FPA Australia enters into major training partnership

Competenz are transforming the way the New Zealand fire industry learn with help from the Fire Protection Association Australia (FPA Australia) and Fire Protection Association New Zealand (FPANZ). The partnership will help deliver best practice industry training to the industry through the development of an online learning solution.

The three parties have committed to working together to share learning content, to support consistency of training between the two countries and enable shared savings in resource development costs.

Specifically, the partnership will allow learning resources developed by FPA Australia to be modified for the New Zealand market and then delivered online by Competenz, supported by FPANZ.

Competenz General Manager Product Development and Quality Assurance Nick Thomson said he hoped to make the new learning materials available to the New Zealand fire protection industry in 2017.

"FPA Australia will shortly provide their learning materials to help inform our development of the new online programmes," he said.

Competenz has assembled a team to transition the content from the Australian context. Once these materials have been adapted to meet the New Zealand requirements, we will be making announcements about the availability of these qualifications."

"These materials have been sorely needed in the New Zealand market for some time and we look

forward to offering them to learners and ensuring the best possible learning materials are developed for this critically important industry."

FPA Australia CEO Scott Williams said the move would lead to more consistent educational outcomes for learners in New Zealand and Australia.

"Our vision is reducing the risk of fire to life property and the environment, for a safer community and this agreement goes a long way towards achieving this," he said.

"This partnership will ensure that best practice fire protection industry training can be conveniently delivered to learners in New Zealand and this will greatly increase the portability of skills as individuals move between our two countries."

Scott Lawson, FPANZ Executive Director said the agreement paved the way for closer ties between all the organisations in the future.

"This initiative is just the start of a strong partnership between our organisations to ensure we can continue to deliver for our members and the broader fire protection industry," he said.

"By sharing resources and costs, all learners will benefit and we know we are delivering the best quality industry training available. FPA Australia should be congratulated on the quality of their training materials, which are world class, and we are delighted to be able to access them."

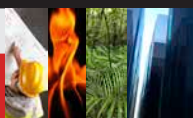
