Membership Process

The process to become a member of the Fire Protection Association of New Zealand or to renew an existing membership is outlined below

Renewal of existing Membership

Existing members of the Fire Protection Association of New Zealand are able to renew their membership providing they have remained a fully paid up financial member from the previous year. If membership has lapsed then the applicant must complete the requirements of a New Member.

- Completed membership form
- Signed copy of the FPANZ Code of Ethical Conduct Declaration
- A copy of current Public Liability insurance policy certificate.

New Members – Individual, Corporate, Organisation

New Membership applications must include all supporting documentation outlined below. Once the application pack is received the Executive Director will review this with the Board of Directors who will advise of the status of the application.

- Completed membership form
- Certificate of Incorporation (where applicable)
- Signed copy of the FPANZ Code of Ethical Conduct Declaration
- A profile of the applicant's business activities
- A brief CV for the applicant's principal Director(s) and/or senior manager(s) who will be directing the applicant's fire safety or fire protection activities, including previous employment with period of employment, roles, qualifications and relevant professional membership
- A copy of current Public Liability insurance policy certificate.
- Names and contact details of 3 unrelated referees (two of which must be clients)
